

“Lunch Money” Program Registration

By registering for this program I authorize PSEG Nuclear Employees Federal Credit Union to debit my checking and/or savings account to pay ARAMARK for meals received as indicated by my signature on the “Lunch Money Authorization Form” (LMAF) for the amount indicated.

Payment is to be made initially from the checking account, if it exists and has funds, with any additional funds paid from my savings account. If there are insufficient funds available to cover the amount, I realize that I will be penalized an “insufficient funds charge¹.” Payment will be made when the LMAF is presented to the Credit Union by ARAMARK, typically the next business day. I will be sent a withdrawal receipt from the Credit Union when payment is made.

A hologram sticker affixed to my PSEG Nuclear Identification Badge indicates my participation in this program. Cafeteria staff will ask to see the sticker to verify my participation. I will return the sticker to the Credit Union if the Credit Union or I decide to terminate my participation. Replacements stickers may result in a \$1.00 charge.

Questions:

I’m not a member, can I use this program?

Sorry, no. Payments are made from members’ accounts. No method for third-party billing is available.

I don’t have a checking account with the Credit Union, can I participate?

Yes. Payment to ARAMARK will be made with funds from your savings account.

What’s with the sticker?

The cafeteria staff needs to be able to identify who is a member of the Credit Union. Putting the sticker on your ID badge lets them compare the name and picture to verify that someone else isn’t charging you for their lunch. Security’s approval was obtained to allow putting the stickers on the badges. Removing the sticker will deface the hologram. You may be charged \$1.00 for a replacement sticker.

Can I use this program only for lunch?

You can sign for any meal at any of the Artificial Island Cafeterias.

Can I use this program off site?

No. This service is being provided in cooperation with the Artificial Island Cafeteria vendor, ARAMARK. Offsite members with Debit Cards can get money from any ATM, without charge at any WAWA.

Is there a maximum amount that I can sign for?

The program is limited to \$15.00 per person per meal.

If I charge less than the total can I get the difference?

No, the cafeterias do not keep enough money on hand to provide this service.

How much of a ‘float’ will I have before the money is deducted from my account?

ARAMARK will be paid shortly after they present the signature sheet to the Credit Union. This could be as soon as the meal period is completed or may take until the next day. You should not expect a delay. Accounts will be penalized an Insufficient Funds Charge if there is not enough money to cover the amount signed for.

Why would the Credit Union decide to terminate my participation in this program?

If there becomes a problem with repeatedly having insufficient funds to pay what you’ve charged or disputes over having made the charges signed for, the Credit Union reserves the right to remove individual participants or terminate the program in total.

¹ The insufficient Funds Charge will be the same penalty as for a ‘bounced check’, currently \$10.
